Dear Colleague:

On behalf of MLSE Foundation, MLSE Launchpad is working on the creation of a Sport for Development Center: a collaborative space that harnesses the power of sport to address a range of youth development priorities such as education, health and improved life skills. It will provide 200,000 underserviced youth access to a multipurpose gymnasium, classrooms and teaching kitchen.

MLSE LaunchPad is the first facility in North America developed specifically to deliver sport for development programming with a focus on four programming pillars: healthy body; healthy mind; ready for school; ready for work. Along with creating unique sport specific programs in-house, MLSE LaunchPad will partner with organizations that are already executing innovative programming in the field of youth development. Our partner organizations will also allow us to identify and support youth from some of the Greater Toronto Area's most underserviced communities. Bringing youth together for a common purpose in a welcoming space will foster community dialogues and relationships.

We are still in the very early stages of developing partnership and we are consulting the community youth to see what services they want most. There is still no information about how much space will be available to partners and what partner programing might look like. Funding has been provided for the development stage and capital stage, but the cost of space has not yet been established, and a financial plan is not yet in place. More detailed plans for the MLSELaunchPad will, of course, also depend on the nature of the partnerships with organizations like yours that emerge in this development phase.

We are only asking you to provide a preliminary expression of interest in participating in MLSE LaunchPad, <u>not a formal commitment</u>. Please let us know what you are interested in. If you are uncertain of your precise needs please offer the best estimate you can for now. Please note that the basic infrastructure will be in place – including washrooms, a kitchen, an entrance lobby, some janitorial space and so on., so you can focus your response on the office and program space you need and any other specific requirements that you have.

We ask that you send back the expression of interested as soon as possible to be considered in our development process. After that we will be contacting your organizations in May 2016 to follow up on the development of MLSE LaunchPad and its services. Between now and September 2016 we will want to talk to all interested groups to make more formal plans for the creation of MLSE LaunchPad and reach clear agreements with the organizations interested. We hope you will continue to participate in the process thank you for your interest in this initiative.
